

# NEWNHAM COLLEGE

## CAMBRIDGE

How to reach the college (see map overleaf):

- a) **By Bus/Coach:** The bus station is located on Drummer Street, with some long-distance coaches arriving at Parkside, just down the road. **Either** take a taxi to Newnham College, **or** from Drummer Street turn into Emmanuel Street, walk to the junction with St Andrew's Street; turn left, then turn right into Downing Street (opposite Emmanuel College, Cambridge Building Society on the corner). Keep going as far as the T-junction with Trumpington Street, turn right, cross the road at the pedestrian crossing and follow Silver Street all the way down to the traffic lights at the cross roads (you will pass Queens' College on your way); Sidgwick Avenue is straight ahead at the crossroads and Newnham College is about 500 metres up on the left side (past Ridley Hall).
- b) **By train:** Trains to and from London's Kings Cross and Liverpool Street operate at regular intervals. From the North connections to Cambridge are best made at Peterborough. From the station you can either take a taxi or catch a city centre bus to Drummer Street and follow the instructions in a). (National Rail Enquiries <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk/> or tel: 0845 48 49 50).
- c) **By air:** The nearest airport is Stansted. There is an hourly coach service and a regular rail link between Stansted and Cambridge.
- d) **By car:** Cambridge is reached by the M11 from the South and by the A1-A14 from the North. **Warning:** the A14 is prone to congestion, especially at rush hours! Driving around the city centre is difficult and parking spaces are very limited. We strongly recommend the Park & Ride facilities: for information see the website at <http://www.cambridgeshire.gov.uk/transport/around/parkandride/>. If you are coming into Cambridge from the west, the Citibus/Unibus no. 4 from Madingley Road Park & Ride stops in Sidgwick Avenue, just outside the College. From the other Park & Ride sites take a bus to Drummer Street and then follow the instructions in a). If you do need to park nearer to College, Sidgwick Avenue forms a crossroads (traffic lights) with the A1134 (Newnham Road or Queens' Road). There are parking meters on Sidgwick Avenue and along Queens' Road. There are a limited number of spaces in the College but, if possible, we prefer to reserve these spaces for people with special needs. **If you require a parking space please contact the Admissions Office in advance of your visit (01223 330471).**

All visitors should report to the Porters' Lodge on arrival.
