

INFORMATION FOR AUDIENCE MEMBERS

We are looking forward to welcoming you to College on Saturday 17 February 2018 for TEDxNewnham. Here are some practical details about your visit.

**TIMINGS**

Part of the TEDx experience is staying for the whole day, to be surprised by things you never knew and to hear about fresh new ideas. **We ask you to arrive between 9.15am and 9.30am to participate in an activity with the Newnham Forest School before the talks begin (see below), and to stay until 5.30pm.** We hope that you will join us afterwards for a celebratory drink in College Hall after the end of the talks.

**FOREST SCHOOL**

Your first challenge: arrive early (9.15am) and come outside to build a model of the famously challenging Newnham Corridor on Clough Lawn! You'll work with pupils from Newnham Croft School and Forest School Leader Liz Bicknell, weaving hazel that has been coppiced in the Newnham Gardens – and experience for yourselves why Forest School is an idea worth spreading.

**PHOTO COLLAGE**

To celebrate the whole of the Newnham community we are creating a collage of photographs that mean 'Newnham' to everyone coming to TEDxNewnham. It doesn't matter what says Newnham to you – the pub, the park, your room, your Director of Studies, the fishmonger or your butcher – we want it to be part of the collage. **SOCIAL MEDIA**



**FILMING**

It is a necessary condition for attending the event that you give us permission to film you: this is a TEDx requirement. We will ask you to sign for this when you register: we will also ask you to give permission to provide your email address to TEDx so that they can follow up with you once, briefly, after the event: again, this is required by the terms of our TEDx licence.

**ACCESSIBILITY**

The Lucia Windsor Room is upstairs: there is a lift available. When you arrive, please ask the team on the registration desk for directions to the lift. There is an accessible toilet upstairs and another downstairs near College Hall, where we will have lunch and where the celebratory drinks reception will be held.



### WHERE TO GO

TEDxNewnham will take place in the Lucia Windsor Room at Newnham College. You can see the location of the Lucia Windsor Room on this map (10); if you don't know College well, then we suggest you head to the Porters Lodge on Sidgwick Avenue (4): there will be signs directing you to the Lucia Windsor Room from there.

### PARKING

Parking is severely limited around College. We have booked the Sidgwick site parking (on the opposite side of Sidgwick Avenue from College), which is first come first served. Alternatively, there are excellent public transport links from Cambridge station.
